- a. 2019 Special Studies
 - i. Hailey de Anda provided historical context for the Special Studies

 - 1. Centralized Ryan White Eligibility: This study has been put on hold at this time
 - 2. Ride Share: A Letter of Support was developed for this study
 - Linguistic and Cultural Competency for the Latinx community: Survey went out to service providers. A Letter of Support was developed for this study
 - 4. Peer Navigation: Currently, there is not a Letter of Support for this study. A directive and update to service standards may be the next step for this study
