Additional Backup Information:

The abutting property owner, Bread & Circus, LLC, requests a surface encroachment of the Sabine Street right -of-way by a proposed ADA ramp. The total encroachment area is approximately 0.0089 acres (387 square feet), and has a volume of 2,912 cubic feet being a portion of Sabine Street (80' right-of-way), being a public right-of-way within the City of Austin, Texas, and being adjacent to Lot 1, Block 37 of the original City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, locally known as 401 Sabine Street.

All affected City departments and utility franchise holders have reviewed the encroachment agreement request and recommend approval.

Registered neighborhood organizations and neighborhood contact teams were notified on 12/31/2020. No objections have been received by the Development Services Department.

The total appraised market value for the entire volume of 2,916 cubic feet is Twelve Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$12,338). A check in the amount of the appraised value has been submitted to the Development Services Department for processing upon approval of this encroachment agreement. In addition, the applicant has reimbursed the City for the cost of the appraisal and the cost of the notice requirements.
