3	affiliates, proposes to construct an affordable multi-family housing development to be
4	known as Village Square and located at or near 115 E. St. Elmo Rd, Austin, TX 78745

6	WHEREAS, the Applicant, its successors, assigns or affiliates, intends to
7	submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs
8	(TDHCA) for 9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the Proposed Development;

1	Revitalization Plan for a specific area within the municipality that requires concerted
2	revitalization efforts (CRP Area); and
3	WHEREAS, the TDHCA awards two points to an applicant with a resolution

5	will contribute "more than any other" to the municipality's "concerted revitalization
6	efforts" in a CRP Area; and
7	WHEREAS, on August 18, 2005, the City Council adopted Ordinance No.
8	20050818-Z001 that created a Concerted Community Revitalization Plan for the area

19	commonly known as South Congress Combined Neighborhood Plan Area (NPA);

21	WHEREAS, the Proposed Development is located within the South Congress
22	NPA; NOW, THEREFORE,
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
24	The City Council confirms that the Applicant's Proposed Development is the
25	development that will contribute most significantly to the concerted revitalization
26	efforts of the South Congress NPA.
