Approve a resolution confirming that an application for competitive 9% housing tax credits for a proposed multi-family development to be located at or near 115 E. St. Elmo Rd, Austin, TX 78745 will contribute more than any other 2021 9% housing tax credit application to the concerted revitalization efforts of the City within the South Congress Combined Neighborhood Plan Area, which is subject to a concerted community revitalization plan.

Additional Backup Information:

If approved, this Resolution will confirm that the proposed development will contribute more than any other proposed development to the City's concerted revitalization efforts. It will be submitted by MHP Village Square, LLC, or an affiliated entity, to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for competitive 9% housing tax credits.

For developments proposed within a municipality, a Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) application can receive points in the category of "Concerted Community Revitalization Plan" (CRP) if it includes a resolution from the local governing body confirming the application as the one that will contribute more than any other LIHTC application to the City's revitalization efforts in a CRP area. Only one application can be designated per CRP area.

TDHCA staff will determine whether or not the development is in a "concerted community revitalization area" as defined in the 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan and, therefore, whether or not the application will receive the associated points.

The proposed development will be located at or near 115 E. St. Elmo Rd, Austin, TX 78745, which is located in District 3, and which is in South Congress Combined Neighborhood Plan Area (NPA) CRP Area.
