ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Living Cities harnesses the collective power of philanthropy, financial institutions and local governments to close racial income and wealth gaps in American cities. Austin was chosen as a member city of the closing the Gaps Network that Living Cities is hosting. Within Closing the Gaps Network, six cities are part of a Year of Reckoning cohort. Through this deep, year-long experience, we will build on the work already underway in our cities, including competency building for staff to equip the City to apply a racial equity analysis to all the city's work. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Management Services Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
