Public comment will be allowed via telephone; no in-person input will be allowed. **All speakers must register in advance (March 2, 2021 by noon).** All public comment will occur at the beginning of the meeting.

To speak remotely at the **March 3, 2021 Environmental Commission Regular Meeting**, members of the public must:

- Call or email the board liaison Kaela Champlin, (512) 974-3443, Kaela.Champlin@austintexas.gov, no later than noon, (the day before the meeting). The following information is required: speaker name, item number(s) they wish to speak on, whether they are for/against/neutral, email address and telephone number (must be the same number that will be used to call into the meeting).
- Once a request to speak has been made to the board liaison, the information to call on the day of the scheduled meeting will be provided either by email or phone call.
- Speakers must call in at least 15 minutes prior to meeting start time in order to speak, late callers will not be accepted and will not be able to speak.
- Speakers will be placed in a queue until their time to speak.
