The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) is distributing Community Development Block Grant - Coronavirus Relief funds (CDBG-CV) for the Texas Emergency Rental Assistance Program (TERAP) and Texas Eviction Diversion Program (TEDP) to provide rental assistance to income-eligible Households economically impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. This rental assistance can pay for up to six months of rent, including rental arrears, with at least one of those months covering a current or future month of rent.

El Buen Samaritano has more than 30 years of experience assisting tenants. Under the one-year contract for \$1,470,207.00, El Buen Samaritano will provide rental assistance in compliance with the TDCA TERAP and TEDP guidelines.

The Housing and Planning Department (HPD) hereby designates El Buen Samaritano as a subrecipient for the TERAP and TEDP, based upon their extensive experience providing assistance to Latino, immigrant, and lowincome individuals to pay utilities, rent, and/or additional specialty health care services. Additionally, El Buen Samaritano has experience collecting income and eligibility information with bilingual staff and a robust IT, data management system, and call center infrastructure.
