Set a public hearing related to an application by AMTEX Multi-Housing LLC, or an affiliated entity, for housing tax credits for a multi-family development that will be financed through the private activity bond program to be known as Decker Lake Apartments, located at or near 6200 Blue Bluff Road, Austin, Texas 78724, within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction. (Suggested date: Thursday, March 25, 2021, Austin City Hall, 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas).

This action sets a public hearing to receive public comment on an application that will be (or has been) submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA). The Applicant, AMTEX Multi-Housing LLC, or an affiliated entity, seeks funding for the Development through 4% Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC) and private activity bonds. After the public hearing, Council will consider a resolution for the proposed development. The property is located within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) near Council District 1.

Proposed Development

AMTEX Multi-Housing LLC plans to develop a 275 unit multi-family development to be located at 6200 Blue Bluff Road, Austin, Texas 78724. The community will be affordable to households earning at or below 60% of the Austin Median Family Income (MFI). The intended target population of the development is the general population. The development is proposed to be partially funded with 4% Low Income Housing Tax Credits and tax-exempt bonds issued by Travis County Housing Finance Corporation (TCHFC). An affiliate of TCHFC will be the General Partner of the Development's Partnership, thereby allowing for a full property tax exemption. No funding from the Austin Housing Finance Corporation is being requested.
