1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a) To discuss and provide further guidance on the Municipal Veteran Courts Policy, there is a need for additional funds for a pilot program due to COVID. This recommendation for the Municipal Veterans Court has already been submitted to the City Council.
- b) The Commission has decided to table the discussion on the proposed Transition Assistance Program. Commissioner Salazar made the motion and Commissioner Just seconded it.
- c) The Commission will draft up a recommendation to City Council on placing a memorial honoring WWII and Vietnam Veterans in East Austin. Upon approval of the recommendation, the recommendation will direct the City Manager to have the Parks and Recreation Department work with the Austin Travis County Vietnam Memorial Association on the placement of the memorial.

3. NEW BUSINESS

COMMISSION ON VETERAN AFFAIRS MEETING MINUTES

a) The Sobering Center provided an update on their efforts and programs benefitting veterans. In FY 19, 160 military and veterans were served and in FY20, 78 military and veterans were served. The Sobering Center enhances Public Health and safety by providing a safe place for publicly intoxicated individuals to sober up as an alternative to the emergent room or jail to provide a bridge to recovery.
