2	WHEREAS, the Austin Travis County Vietnam Memorial Association
4	(ATCVMA) recognizes and honors those Travis County veterans who served in
5	all the United States armed conflicts; and
6	WHEREAS, ATCVMA is a non-profit raising funds with the goal of
7	placing a Veterans Memorial in East Austin; and
8	WHEREAS, by setting aside space at Edward Rendon Sr. Park at Festival
9	Beach for the placement of a Veterans Memorial the City will ensure that future
10	generations can honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice for preserving
11	freedoms; and
12	WHEREAS, veterans represent a cross-section of the United States that
13	includes a diversity of Americans, not the least of, Asians, African Americans,
14	LatinX, and Native Americans, male and female; and
15	WHEREAS, East Austin represents one of the most diverse communities
16	in Austin of those who made the ultimate sacrifice to preserve our freedoms; and
17	WHEREAS, the community in East Austin supports the placement of a
18	Veterans Memorial in the East Austin community; and
19	WHEREAS, the Commission on Veteran Affairs approved
20	recommendation 20200923-C003 encouraging the Austin City Council to work

21	with the Austin Travis County Vietnam Memorial Association to find a prominent
22	location for a Veterans Memorial; NOW, THEREFORE,
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
24	The Council directs the City Manager to work with the Austin Travis
25	County Vietnam Memorial Association to identify a prominent location within
26	Edward Rendon Sr. Park at Festival Beach for a Veterans Memorial, add the
27	location to the adopted Holly Shores/ Edward Rendon Sr. Metro Park vision
28	plan, and report back on or before September 1, 2021.
