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1. the Applicant provided notice to the City Council as required by Subsection (a);
and
2. the City Council had sufficient opportunity to obtain a response from the Applicant regarding any questions or concerns about the proposed Development; and
3. the City Council has held a hearing at which public comment could be made on the proposed Development as required by Subsection(b); and

22 4. after due consideration of the information provided by the Applicant and public
23 comment, the City Council does not object to the Applicant's proposed application
24 to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

26 Pursuant to Section 11.3(c) of Texas' 2021 Qualified Allocation Plan and Section
27 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council expressly
28 acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state average of units
29 per capita supported by Housing Tax Credits or Private Activity Bonds.

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

31 Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections
32 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the
33 proposed Development; approves the construction of the Development; and authorizes
34 an allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the Development.
