Additional Backup Information:

Funding will be provided for a three-month contract in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 with El Buen Samaritano (El Buen) to provide financial assistance to low-income households whose housing was impacted by Winter Storm Uri.

El Buen will collaborate with community organizations to identify low-income households whose housing was significantly impacted by Winter Storm Uri. This impact could include lack of water, gas, or electricity for an extended period of time or damage due to the impacts of the storm. Eligible households will receive \$1,000 to cover the costs of hotel accommodations or other temporary accommodations if needed. Funding may also be used to replace essential household items necessary for safe and decent housing and for relocation purposes to include deposits, rent, and utility payments, which can provide residents with flexibility to explore options for a more stable housing solution. This direct financial assistance model has been successful in the Relief In A State of Emergency (RISE) program to stabilize residents in need of short-term housing options.

El Buen is a highly qualified non-profit with over 30 years' experience and is prepared to deploy large scale emergency support and financial assistance. El Buen has been actively providing assistance to Latino, immigrant, and low-income individuals to pay utilities, rent, and/or additional specialty health care services since 2008. In 2020, El Buen distributed close to \$4,000,000 in RISE financial assistance to more than to 2000 families affected by the COVID pandemic.
