  - City staff: SMBR, Financial Services, Equity Office, and Law
  - MBE/WBE Stakeholders: Minority Trade Alliance, Minority Chambers, Prime and subcontractors, and MBE/WBE and Small Business Enterprise Procurement Advisory Committee
- ▶ Purpose: Review and consider the recommendations from Disparity Study
  - Four major areas: Certification, Best Practices, Communication & Transparency, and Resources to MBEs and WBEs
- ▶ Memo to Mayor & City Council November 4, 2020
  - Outlined all members of the IPWG
  - Proposed a Tentative Schedule and Action Plan to accomplish identified tasks
  - Tentative first meeting of the IPWG in August 2021
