

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint’s permanent supportive housing goal is too low and does not reflect the City Council’s priorities and current community needs; and

WHEREAS, a community-led Homelessness Summit held between March 23 and April 15, 2021 established the goal of housing over 3,000 people experiencing homelessness in three years, including the development of 1,000 units of permanent supportive housing; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council directs the City Manager to amend the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint to reflect the following goals:

- Unlock 3,000+ Homes by 2024 through a collaboration between local governments, businesses, and philanthropy with the goal of significantly reducing Austin's unsheltered population
 - Secure 2,300 rental units in the market using landlord incentives
 - Provide capital funds for at least 350 Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) units per year beginning in FY2022
