RESOLUTION NO. 1 WHEREAS, the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint's permanent supportive 2 3 housing goal is too low and does not reflect the City Council's priorities and 4 current community needs; and 5 WHEREAS, a community-led Homelessness Summit held between March 23 and 6 April 15, 2021 established the goal of housing over 3,000 people experiencing homelessness in three years, including revamping our response system; providing 7 8 housing stabilization such as prevention, diversion and rapid exit; fully rehousing 9 across the spectrum of need; and specifically including the development of 1,000 10 units of permanent supportive housing; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN: 11 12 The City Council directs the City Manager to amend the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint to reflect the following goals: 13 Unlock 3,000+ Homes by 2024 through a collaboration between local 14 governments, businesses, and philanthropy with the goal of significantly 15 reducing Austin's unsheltered population. Such a collaboration would 16 rehouse those living in encampments equitably and set a course to reach 17 equilibrium on unsheltered homelessness in which the homelessness 18 19 response system has a rehousing intervention within 30 days for all persons experiencing homelessness. 20 Secure 2,300 rental units in the market using landlord incentives 21 Provide capital funds for at least 350 Permanent Supportive Housing 22 (PSH) units per year beginning in FY2022 23 24
