

WHEREAS, the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint’s permanent supportive housing goal is too low and does not reflect the City Council’s priorities and current community needs; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- Unlock 3,000+ Homes by 2024 through a collaboration between local governments, businesses, and philanthropy with the goal of significantly reducing Austin's unsheltered population. Such a collaboration would rehouse those living in encampments equitably and set a course to reach equilibrium on unsheltered homelessness in which the homelessness response system has a rehousing intervention within 30 days for all persons experiencing homelessness.
- Secure 2,300 rental units in the market using landlord incentives.

- Provide capital funds for at least 350 Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) units per year beginning in FY2022.
