The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special elections as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the elections; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Propositions A, B, C, D and E are adopted and that Propositions F, G and H are not adopted.

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
