



COVID-19 Progress Towards Herd Immunity Austin - Travis County



COVID-19 Austin MSA New Admissions




Filtered Moving Average of Admissions




COVID-19 AUSTIN MSA CURRENT HOSPITALIZATIONS, ICU ADMISSIONS, AND VENTILATOR USE




City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Age Group (Austin MSA)



City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Race/Ethnicity (Austin MSA)




Percent Positive by Test Collection Week and Year - Last 12 Weeks






COVID-19: Breakthrough and Reinfections

- **Breakthrough**

- 124 Infections (0.02%)
- 7 Hospitalizations (All age >50)
- 2 Deaths (All age >70)

- **Reinfection (under investigation)**

- 362 potential reinfections (0.43%)
- 44 Hospitalizations
- 4 Deaths

Stage 2 Recommendations

- Fully vaccinated individuals can participate in indoor and outdoor **private** gatherings and dine and shop **without** precautions if allowed by business.
- Partially vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals can participate in indoor and outdoor **private** gatherings and dine and shop **with** precautions.
- Everyone, regardless of vaccination status, can travel **with** precautions.


