## RESOLUTION NO.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Austin, Travis County, and the State of Texas issued disaster declarations relative to each jurisdiction in response to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic in order to protect public health; and,

**WHEREAS**, the United States government has provided certain funds to aid the City in addressing unforeseen financial needs and risks created by the COVID-19 public health emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the council has passed resolutions and ordinances to allocate and appropriate funds to provide relief services and assistance to Austin residents, creatives, non-profits, and businesses to address the needs created by this public health emergency and to provide longer-term resiliency for Austin residents to help support the health of Austin residents and the Austin economy; and,

WHEREAS, City staff introduced a proposed spending framework for the City of Austin's American Rescue Plan Act allocation to the council on March 23, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, City staff presented a revised proposed spending framework for the City of Austin's American Rescue Plan Act allocation to the council on May 18, 2021, in response to Council Resolution No. 20210325-111; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The council authorizes the City Manager to use federal American Rescue Plan Act funds, additional federal funding received by the City of Austin, and City funds in substantially the categories and allotments reflected in Exhibit A: the American Rescue Plan Act Spending Framework.

## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The council authorizes the City Manager to use the funds flexibly so as to maximize the lawful use of the federal funds within the framework established by the applicable federal programs, and then to use City funds to the extent needed to address needs that the council has prioritized but that are not funded by the federal programs.
