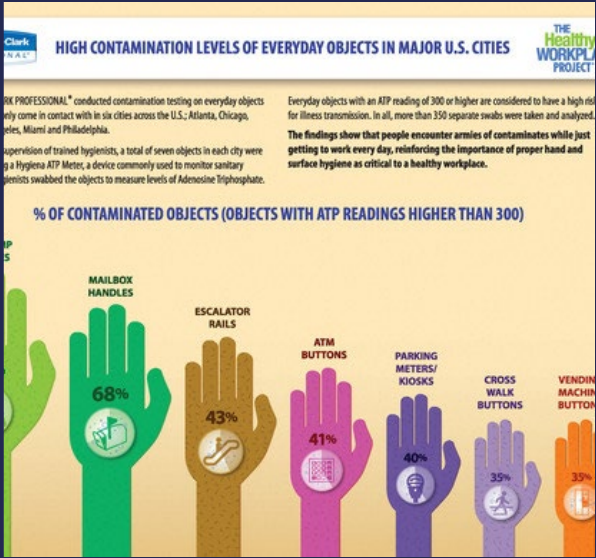
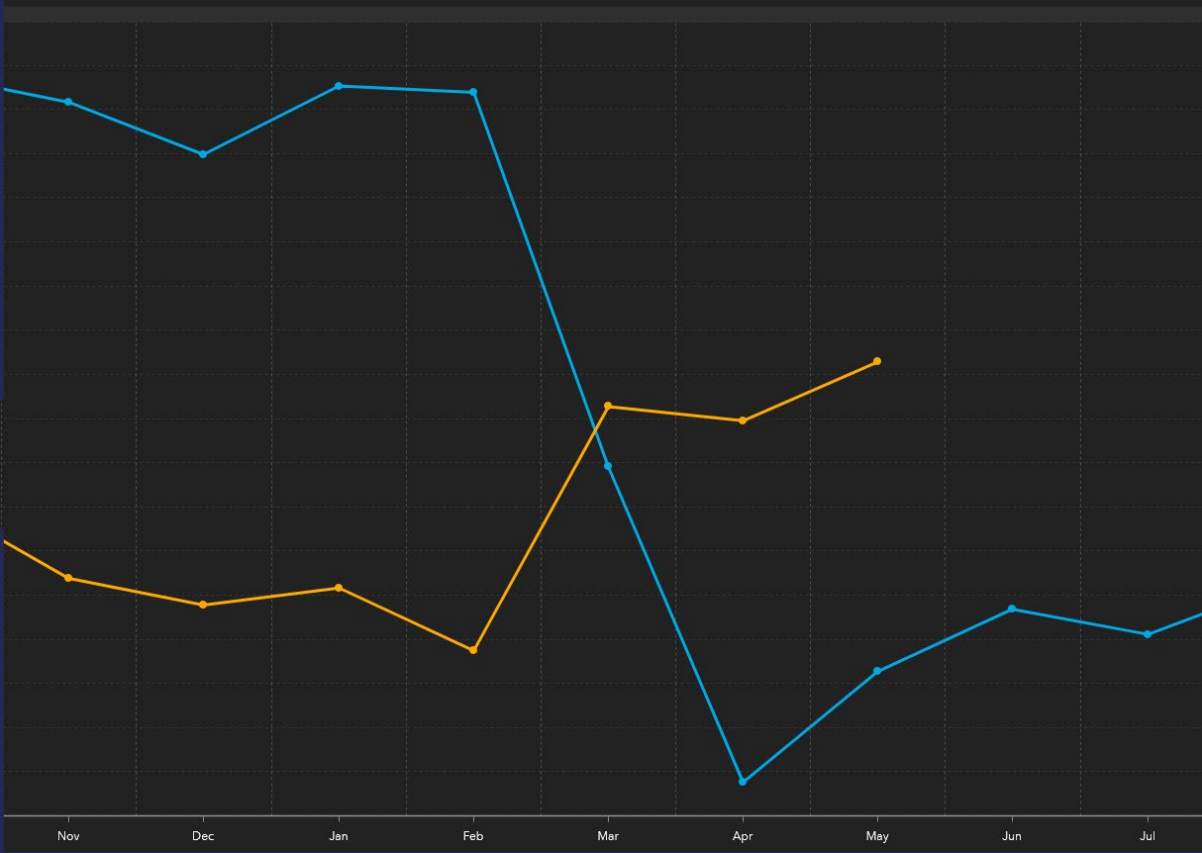

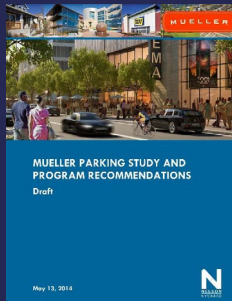

TRANSPORTATION

Where We Left Off



- **Phase One (Aug. 2016 – Oct. 2018)**
 - Approx. 289 parking spaces
 - 26 pay stations & 7 single space meters
- **Phase Two (Late Fall 2018 to Early 2019) – Complete**
 - Approx. 200 additional parking spaces
 - First set of spaces opening on Garcia Street south, including Aldrich and Philomena
 - Additional spaces north of Garcia anticipated to be metered by end of year
- **Phase Three (Paused COVID - 2021) – Proposing larger expansion of parking regulations**

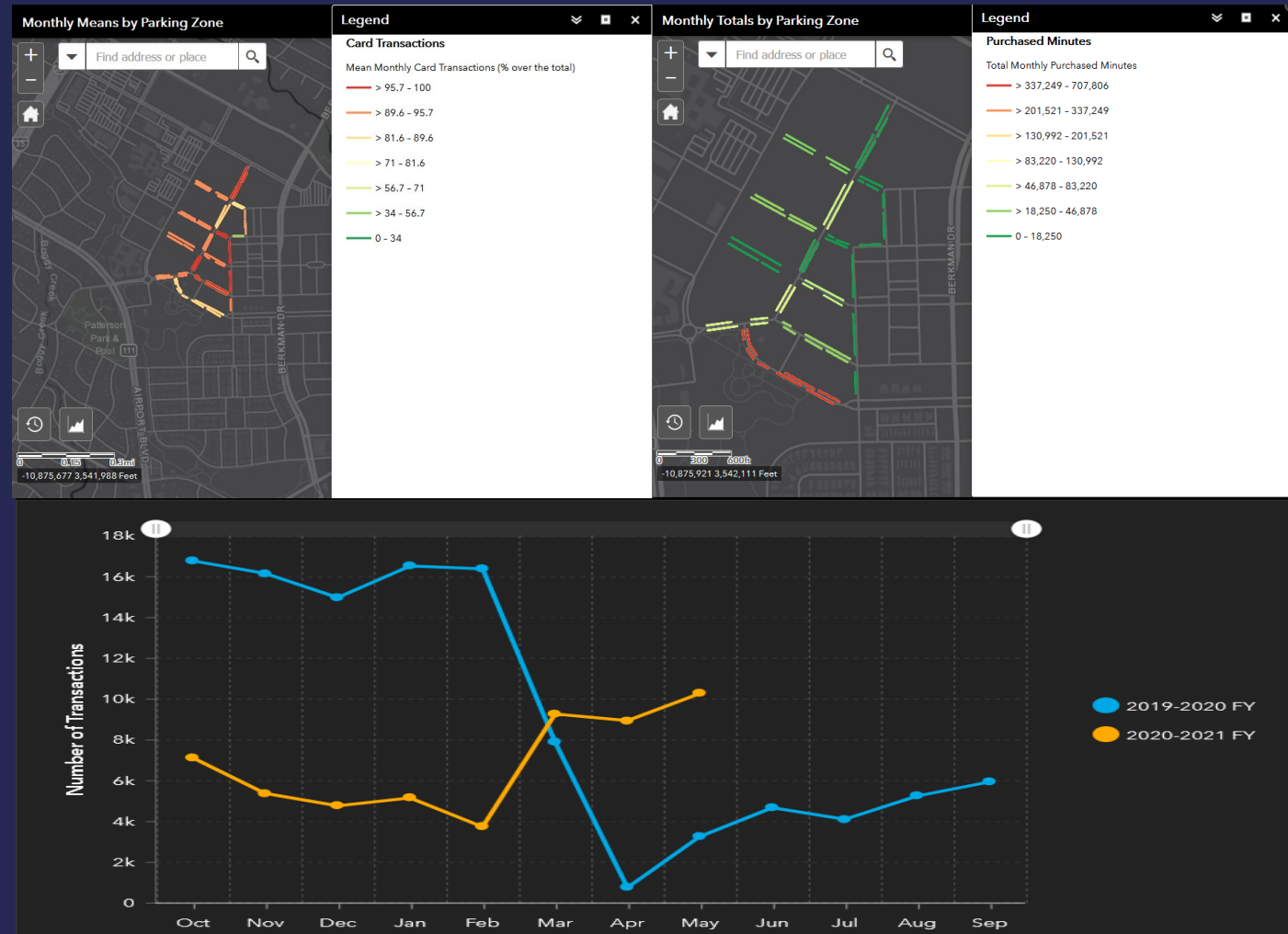


Curb Management Overview

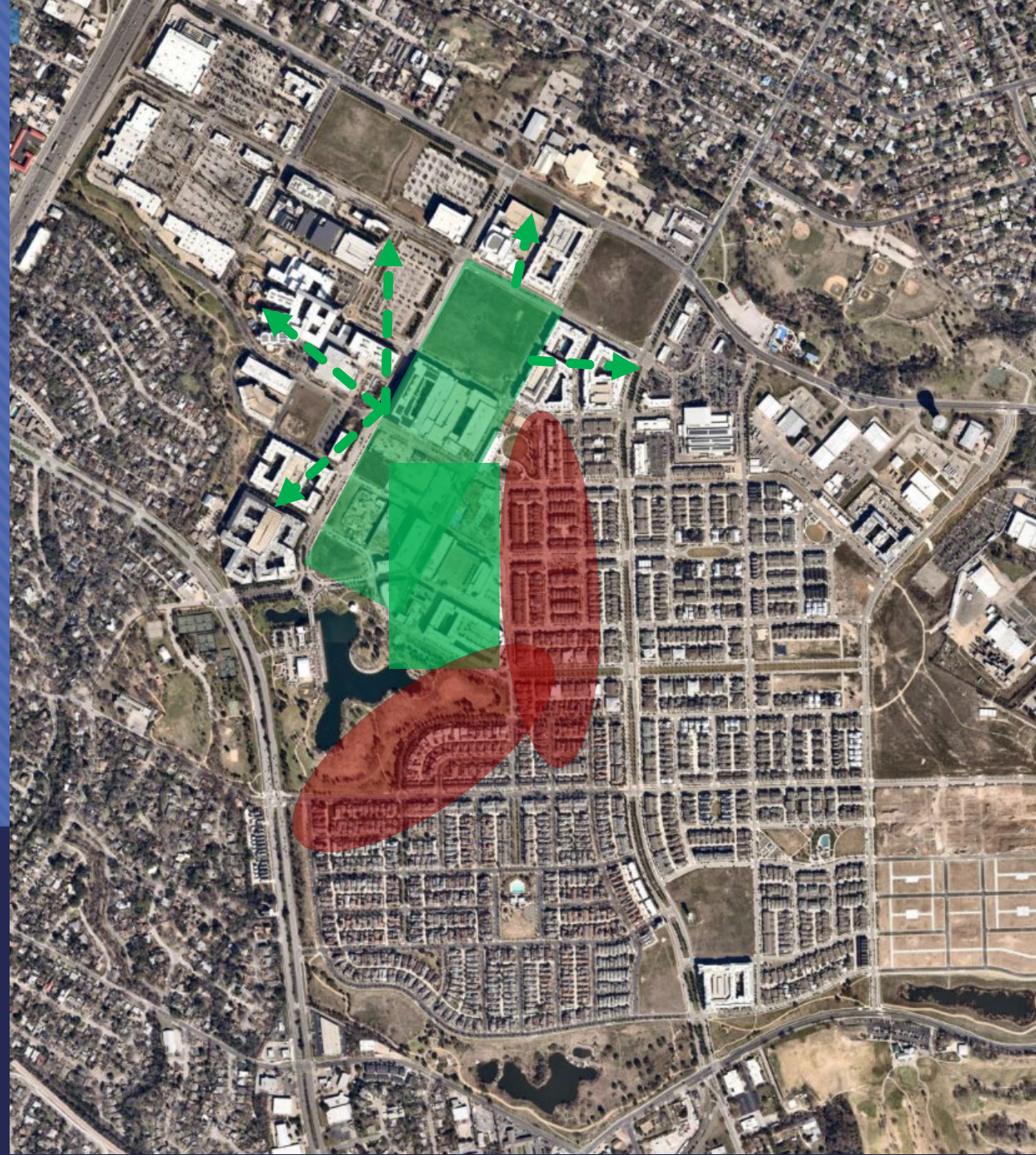

Monitoring & Potential Parking Regulation Expansion

- Increase in off-street parking – long term parking
- Farmers Market and other attractions
- Phased approach will cause more confusion –More Choices = More Circling
- Monitor overflow parking in residential areas that abut the commercial district

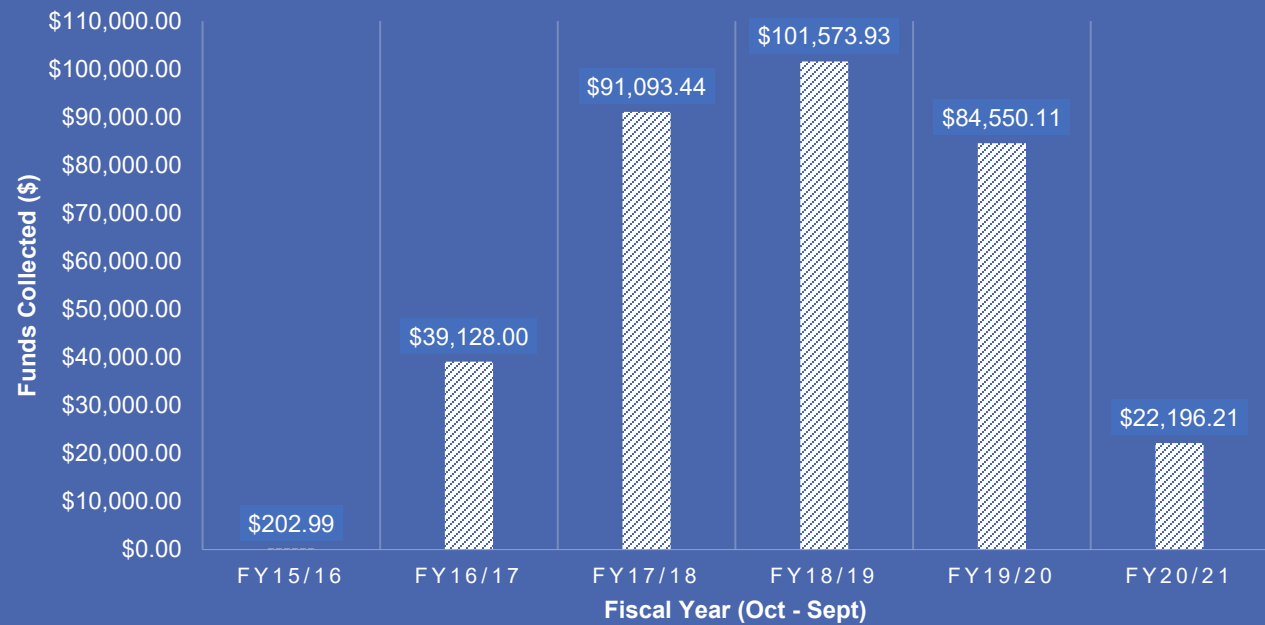

Administrative review for currently COA Vendors

No COA Contract = Procurement

Next Steps + Future Planning

- Refine PTMD administrative process
- Project request process refinement
 - How to collect feedback
 - Web-based community engagement
- Residential Permit Parking Program review and possible hybrid curb pilot
- Reduction of physical pay stations
- Parking regulation expansion to the rest of on-street parking spaces to provide consistency
- Sunday enforcement??
