

## AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MONDAY, MAY 17, 2021

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called meeting on Monday, May 17, 2021 via Videoconference.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 1:07 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem Harper-Madison, Council Member's Casar, Renteria were absent.

## DISCUSSION

1. Discussion regarding City operations, response, and future actions as described in Resolution No. 20210325-067 related to the February 2021 Winter Storm event (Winter Storm Uri).

Direction was given to staff to gather information on community sourced sheltering, to get a better picture of what was happening outside of the city and what lessons we learned from that, both appreciative of that action, of volunteers stepping in, but how do we best assist that or redirect that or facilitate. To include the results of the Commission on Seniors analysis in the after-action report. Research ways to implement a process to reach out to seniors living in the community. How do we fund situations outside of our system? What are funding options for future resilience HUBS.
