

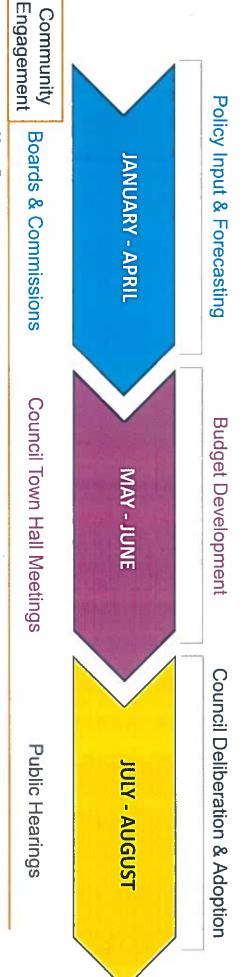

City of Austin FY22 Budget Timeline





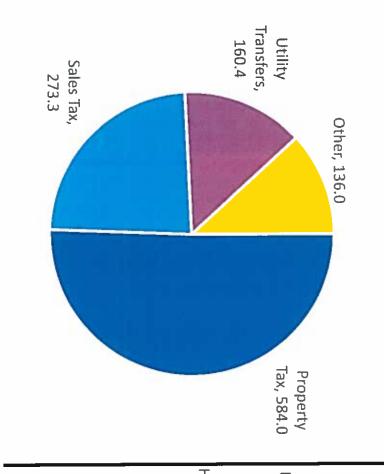

- August 11 Budget and tax rate adoption

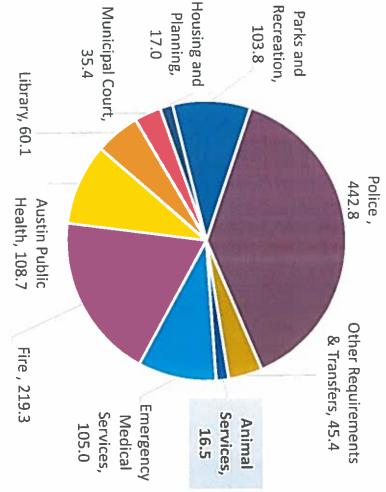
FY 22 General Fund Budget - \$1.2B

FY22 Source of Funds (\$ millions)



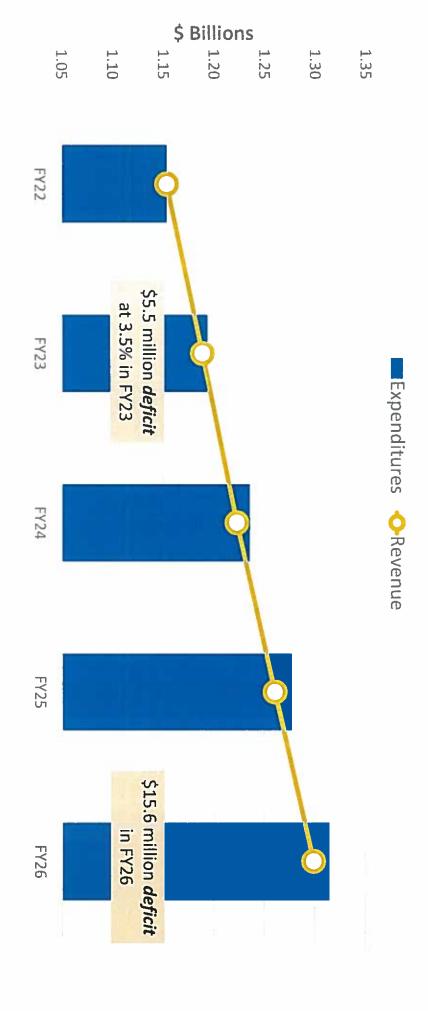
FY22 Use of Funds (\$ millions)

FY22 Animal Services Budget - Highlights



BASE COST DRIVERS - GENERAL FUND

- \uparrow \$151K Citywide allocations (2% wage adjustment, insurance, pension, support functions, etc.)
- \uparrow \$98K contracts for emergency and specialty care and Austin Humane Society sterilization services
- ↑ \$60K rabies and titers vaccinations
- ↑ \$55K \$500 one-time civilian compensation (Citywide)
- ↑ \$39K vet services increased drug costs and equipment replacements

ONE-TIME FUNDING - CAPITAL BUDGET

- 个 \$400K surgery recovery kennels (in Austin Public Health capital budget)
- ↑ \$200K play yard upgrades and repairs (in Building Services capital budget)
