Additional Backup Information:

This action amends the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Service Agreement with the City of Austin to increase available funds in the amount of \$500,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$77,204,657. These funds are Community Development Block Grant Funds.

The Texas Emergency Mortgage Assistance Program (TEMAP) provides mortgage assistance to incomeeligible homeowners impacted by COVID-19. The program can pay up to six consecutive months of all or part of an eligible household's mortgage payments, including mortgage arrears, with at least one of those months covering a future monthly mortgage payment.
