Authorize award and execution of a construction contract with Rider Construction Group, LLC, for the Rosewood Neighborhood Park - Court Renovation project in the amount of \$399,000 plus a \$39,900 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$438,900.

Additional Backup Information:

The existing asphalt tennis courts at Rosewood Neighborhood Park will be replaced with new concrete courts due to cracks and breaks in the current surface. In addition to the two tennis courts, the surface will provide non-traditional uses including pickle ball, futsal, quick start tennis, four squares, and hopscotch. Additional improvements include replacing a portion of fencing.

Operations of the neighborhood park and recreation center will not be impacted by construction and will remain open. The pool and splash pad will close for the season prior to the start of construction and will not be impacted by the project. Construction is anticipated to commence Fall 2021.

Due to the potential for unknown site conditions that may be encountered during construction, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. A contingency is an additional amount of money added to the construction budget to cover any unforeseen

construction costs associated with the project. By authorizing the additional contingency funding, Council is authorizing any change orders within the contingency amount.
