The requested increase of \$70,514 represents the difference between the approved grant appropriation in the 2 2021 Fiscal Year and the total grant award of \$7,149,941. The additional funds will be used to cover increases in personne operation costs, and not expected to increase performance measures. The additional three full-time equivalent positions (f will consist of Breastfeeding Peer Counselors that will ensure appropriate lactation support services are available to WIC cl and will align with the additional Breastfeeding Peer Counselor funding provided by the grant in Fiscal Year 2020-2021.
