**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The current approved grant appropriation in the Fiscal Year 2020-21 budget is \$37,000. The requested increase of \$14,804 represents the difference between the approved grant appropriation for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and the revised total grant award of \$51,804.

Austin Public Health will allocate Ending Homelessness Funds to provide financial assistance to support the new Homeless Housing and Services Program, Youth Set Aside Program for operations, transitional housing, case management, street outreach and housing assistance for homeless youth and young adults up to age 24 through its partnership with the Youth and Family Alliance, Inc., d/b/a Lifework's.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, Austin Public Health Department's need for continued funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
