Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract with Roadway Asset Services, LLC, to provide traffic sign data collection services, in an amount not to exceed \$398,000.

(Note: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9C Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program and subcontractor goals were applied to the solicitation. The subcontracting goals were exceeded, and the resulting contract will include 2.00% MBE and 3.00% WBE participation).

Additional Backup Information:

The contract is for traffic sign data collection services on City maintained roads located within City limits. The service provider will use field data collection technology to provide the City with a comprehensive database of all City street signs and sign poles, including the sign's location, condition, and message. Once collected, this data will be incorporated into Austin Transportation's asset management system, where it will be updated on

an ongoing basis by street sign operations staff. This data will allow staff to conduct maintenance planning and proactively address sign-related safety issues on City roadways.

An evaluation team with expertise in this area evaluated the offers and scored Roadway Asset Services, LLC as the best to provide these services based on system concept and solutions proposed, demonstrated applicable experience, personnel qualifications, price, local preference, and service-disabled veteran business enterprise.

Approving this contract will allow the City to have an accurate dataset of sign support locations and sign assets. This data will be used in planning work on the City streets.
