#### Additional Backup Information:

In accordance with Austin Water financial policies, a public hearing is required during the City's annual budget review process to provide citizens an opportunity to comment on Austin Water growth-related projects within the Drinking Water Protection Zone (DWPZ).

Capital improvement projects for new water and wastewater treatment plants, capital expansions, and growthrelated projects that are located in the DWPZ were identified and submitted as part of the annual budget process to the following Boards and Commissions: Water and Wastewater Commission, Resource Management Commission, Environmental Commission, Planning Commission, and the Zoning and Platting Commission.

These Boards and Commissions reviewed Austin Water growth-related DWPZ capital projects spending plans, provided input, reviewed consistency with Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan, reviewed effect on growth within the DWPZ, and made recommendations on projects. All Boards and Commissions recommended approval to include Austin Water DWPZ projects in Austin Water 5-year capital spending plan.
