Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide a prefabricated modular building at the City's Dalton Lane campus. The modular building will house approximately 45 Public Works staff members currently in temporary or leased spaces. Public Works does not have immediate plans for utilizing the maximum capacity but has near-term personnel increases factored into the building design. Should the maximum capacity be reached, the design flexibility of the building allows for multiple solutions for which additional modular units could be joined to the original structure.

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Completion and occupancy of the new Dalton Lane field office will allow for an immediate office space for the Street and Bridge Division as field personnel will no longer have employees commute from other facilities to this location for work. There is currently no onsite covered workspace for employees at this facility. Public Works will also be able to have an improved Continuity of Operations Plan that will more appropriately meet the emergency and operational needs of the department.
