# HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION Application for a Certificate of Appropriateness August 23, 2021 HR-2021-119797 Hyde Park Historic District 4409 Avenue C

## PROPOSAL

Replace aluminum windows on rear addition with vinyl windows.

### **PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS**

Install 11 vinyl windows on an addition to the back of the house without altering size or location of existing openings. The windows proposed for replacement include non-original jalousie and fixed-pane windows at the rear of the building at an enclosed porch.

#### ARCHITECTURE

One-story Ranch-style house with partial-width inset porch, horizontal siding, and side-gabled roof.

## **DESIGN STANDARDS**

The Hyde Park Design Standards are used to evaluate projects within the historic district. The following standards apply to the proposed project:

3.3.4. If replacing windows, use windows that approximate the size and match the scale, profile, appearance, and configuration of existing historic windows.

The proposed project affects only non-original windows on a non-historic addition. Existing openings will not change in size or shape. While vinyl would not be an appropriate replacement material for historic-age windows and/or windows visible from the street, the proposed project does not impact original material or streetscape views.

#### <u>Summary</u>

The project mostly meets the applicable standard.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Approve the application. The proposed windows are not visible from the street and affect a non-historic enclosed screened porch only.
