Again, Thank you for holding this meeting to gather public input into your process. It is very much appreciated. You have accepted a difficult task given many factors let alone the delayed 2020 census data. I truly respected your service to our community.

Below are a few general meeting procedures you should consider at your next meeting:

- Publicize your public hearings to a broader audience - Meeting notices are not reaching the general public
- Speaker sign-up should be clearly indicated at the sign-in table
 - I missed the sign-in table altogether
- Reformat the worksheets for better responses - worksheets are not self-evident
 - The question list is helpful but difficult to address on the small district map
 - Provide fill-in the blanks on the questions
 - Have one table size large map, giving participants colored dot stickers to place indicating places for worship, education, shopping, etc.
- Commissioners should not provide personal positions from the dais

I personally felt that Commissioner Camellia Falcon's statement from the dais today was an inappropriate, personal rant that jeopardizes the integrity of the commission's work. I wondered if the ICRC had not taken the CoA Boards and Commission ethics class. In the future, I hope the ICRC can find a more appropriate way for commissioners to submit their input to the ICRC.
