ORDINANCE NO. 20210826-052

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20080821-032 TO GRANT AN ADDITONAL THREE-YEAR EXTENSION OPTION TO THE LICENSE AGREEMENT GRANTING ZNET TEXAS, LP, USE OF CITY RIGHT OF WAY FOR SUBSURFACE CONDUIT PLACEMENT IN DOWNTOWN AUSTIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. FINDINGS.

- (1) On May 18, 2000, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2000518-052 granting ZNET of Austin, Inc. a license to install in the City's rights of way conduit infrastructure consisting of ten duct systems paired with manholes to provide conduit space for wire facilities.
- On August 21, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20080821-032 granting ZNET, Texas, LP, successor to ZNET of Austin, Inc., a revised license to maintain its remaining four duct systems in the City right of way, for a ten-year term with one three-year extension option, the terms of which expire on September 1, 2021

PART 2. Section 12(B) of Part 1 of Ordinance No. 20080821-032 is amended to read as follows:

(B) Grantee has an option to renew this license for two additional three-year terms [one additional three year term] under the same terms and conditions, provided Grantee has fully complied with all terms and conditions of this license. If Grantee elects to exercise a [the] renewal, it must file a written notice with the City no fewer than six months prior to expiration of the then-current [original ten year] license term.
