  - iv. Additions to the resolution included updating language to reflect work is being done but there needs to be more progress, highlight homebound individuals, and people living with disabilities.
  - v. The Resolution requesting Austin Public Health prioritize COVID-19 Vaccine appointments for older adults was adopted on Commissioner Lugo motion, Commissioner Van Sickle second on a 12-0 vote. Commissioners Angel and Nicola were absent.
