Energy Efficiency Program 2022-2024

Conservation Adjustment Clause

Texas Gas Service will provide the City of Austin Resource Management
Commission ("Commission") or successor board or commission the proposed
program selection and budget no later than 45 days prior to a budget filing. The
Commission will review the program selection and budget, provide input and
make a recommendation to the City of Austin. Public comment and/or input shall
be heard by the Commission during these meetings.



Proposed 2022-24 Budget and Programs:

Proposed Changes

- Sunset: Annual Furnace Tune-Up rebate
- Rebate Revision: Natural Gas Tankless Water Heaters
 - **Residential Retrofit:** *reduce* the rebate for the 0.82 UEF units from \$650 to \$400
 - We will offer a new \$650 rebate for the higher efficiency (0.93 UEF) tankless water heater
 - New Residential Construction: reduce rebate for the 0.82 UEF unit from \$400 to \$275
 - We will offer a new \$425 rebate for the higher efficiency (0.93 UEF) tankless water heater
- Conservation Adjustment Charge reduction for residential customers from \$1.19/mo. to \$1.09/mo.
