Additional Backup Information:

The City of Austin Corridor Program Office is constructing improvements to the Burnet Road corridor to increase safety, mobility, and connectivity for everyone. This project will include an upgraded traffic signal, repurposed pavement width to provide an eastbound right-turn lane from RM 2222 onto Burnet Road and a westbound right-turn lane from RM 2222 onto Burnet Road, raised median islands, White Rock Drive intersection improvements, the addition of a landscaped pedestrian buffer in front of Lamar Middle School, bus stop improvements including the relocation of two bus stops in coordination with Capital Metro, placemaking along RM 2222, and shared-use paths. This segment of Burnet Road from RM 2222 to MoPac Expressway is approximately five miles.

Through the 2016 Mobility Bond, the Corridor Program Office was awarded \$482 million. From this allotment, funding was allocated to design and construct mobility and safety improvements to the Burnet Road corridor. From this, Burnet Road between RM 2222 and MoPac Expressway is funded through construction.

A portion of Burnet Road passes through Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) right-of-way (ROW) at RM 2222. These mobility and safety improvements require a multiple-use agreement (MUA) between the City of Austin and TxDOT to establish roles and responsibilities for construction and maintenance of the improvements within TxDOT ROW.

This project is located within District #7.
