WHEREAS, the Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission has been established to ensure general compliance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code, the local Civil Service Rules established by the Commission, and any current agreements between the City of Austin and associations representing firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Commission may take action on matters related to promotion, appeals of promotional exams, suspension and termination, as well as other matters regarding firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel in accordance with the above-mentioned statutes, rules and agreements; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 143.006 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that the City Manager will appoint three Commissioners for staggered terms, and that the appointment must be confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 143.006 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that the City Manager's reappointment of a commission member to more than a third consecutive term must be confirmed by a two thirds majority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Eyna Canales-Zarate is a current member of the Commission since January 2015, having been appointed to a third term expiring October 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has reappointed Ms. Canales-Zarate to a new, fourth term beginning November 1, 2021 and ending October 31, 2024, and Ms. Canales-Zarate meets the statutory prerequisites for appointment to this position; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council confirms the City Manager's reappointment of Enya Canales-Zarate to the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission for the new term beginning November 1, 2021 and ending October 31, 2024.
