Posting Language

Authorize award of three multi-term contracts with Ferguson Waterworks, Core and Main, LP, and ACT Pipe and Supply, Inc. to provide fire hydrant parts, each for up to five years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,640,590, divided among the contractors.

(Note: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9D Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. For the goods required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Of the three offers received, the recommended contractors submitted the lowest responsive offers. The contract will replace a contract that expires on December 23, 2021. The requested authorization amount is based on historical spending and forecasted needs.
