




Eviction Filings in Travis County Over Time






Eviction Filings in Travis County by JP









Eviction Filings during COVID-19








Eviction filings By Council District Since COVID-19 Based on partial dataset

COVID Eviction Protections Since Onset of Pandemic



Justice Courts

Current Local Protections



Mayoral/County Judge Orders= Many Notices to Vacate Prohibited Expires October 15th



Justice Courts = Pause on Many Nonpayment Hearings Expires October 15th



City of Austin Cure Ordinance = Give Tenants 60 Day Grace Period Expires October 15th

Landlord must exhaust rental assistance remedies before proceeding with nonpayment eviction with more than 3 months of arrears: **RENT 3.0 Travis County ERAP Texas Rent Relief** 3) Must wait 45 days from application.




