August 11, 2021 - City Council approved Ordinance No. 20210811-002, that authorized fees, fines, and other charges to be set or charged by the City for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 beginning on October 1, 2021 and ending on September 30, 2022. That included changes from the prior fiscal year for certain Austin Fire Department fees.
