

**Amendment No. 2**  
**To Contract CT 5500-19112700146**  
**For training, technical assistance and small business coaching services to creative businesses**  
**Between Business Investment Growth (BIG Austin)**  
**And the City of Austin**

1.0 On October 15, 2020, Austin City Council approved an amendment to contract CT 5500-19112700146 to extend the contract's term to December 31, 2021. However, the provision of training, technical assistance and coaching services has been slowed due to COVID-19. Both parties wish to extend the term of the contract to allow services to be completed.

2.0 The term of the contract is extended through December 31, 2022. There are no extension options. The total contract authorization is recapped below:

3.3.1 Contractor shall plan and deliver 20 training webinars targeted to creative for-profit and non-profit audiences.


3.4.2.9 Contractor shall deliver up to 460 hours of one-on-one coaching to creative for-profit and non-profit practitioners and organizations.
