

RESOLUTION NO. 20211115-001

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021, special municipal elections were held to present to the voters one proposed ordinance to amend the City Code (Proposition A) and one measure to authorize City Council to convey a tract of city parkland and the terms and conditions of such a conveyance (Proposition B); voters were given the option of voting “for” or “against” each measure; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the special elections have been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against the propositions were cast as follows:

Proposition A

For	49,644
Against	106,413

Proposition B

For	110,995
Against	40,481

WHEREAS, a majority of all votes cast in the Proposition A special election were cast against Proposition A, and a majority of all votes cast in the Proposition B special election were cast for Proposition B; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special elections as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the elections; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Proposition A is not adopted, and Proposition B is adopted.

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
