#### Additional Backup Information:

On November 18, 2021, Council directed the City Manager to act with expediency to ensure Arts and Culture Nonprofit Relief Grant recipients receive funds by December 31, 2021. This action will amend the FY 2022 Cultural Arts Fund to appropriate \$500,000 for Arts and Culture Nonprofit Relief Grants to serve 25 additional applicants.

In response to the ongoing financial hardships caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, Austin City Council approved creation of the Austin Art and Culture Non-profit Relief Grant. Following the City Council's direction, the Economic Development Department (EDD) sought a third-party non-profit to administer these relief programs. This action would enable EDD to amend its contract with the Better Business Bureau to administer and provide additional grants to arts and culture non-profits.
