## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING A PRESIDING JUDGE, ASSOCIATE JUDGES INCLUDING THE DOWNTOWN AUSTIN COMMUNITY COURT JUDGE, AND SUBSTITUTE JUDGES TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN FOR THE TERM BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2022, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025; AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** The council appoints Sherry Statman as the presiding judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Austin for the term beginning January 1, 2022, and ending December 31, 2025.
