I am opposed to the new City Council District maps. The newly drawn section that moves portions of Precincts 212, 221, 307, 318, 338 from District 10 to District 8 makes District 8 too large in population, which would dilute the representation we currently have in SW Austin. We have significant issues in District 8 that we do not share with the areas that you plan to move.

We encourage you to use the boundary of Eanes ISD as the natural boundary of the District and revert to the original maps submitted by the committee.
