

**ORDINANCE NO. 20211118-066**

**AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE CITY OF AUSTIN'S BOUNDARY LIMITS BY RELEASING APPROXIMATELY 31 ACRES GENERALLY LOCATED IN EASTERN TRAVIS COUNTY NEAR THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE AND ADJACENT TO THE COLORADO RIVER FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Texas Local Government Code Section 42.023 authorizes a city to reduce its extraterritorial jurisdiction by giving written consent by ordinance or resolution. The Austin City Charter, Article I, Section 6, provides that the City may reduce its boundary by ordinance.

**PART 2.** Approximately 31 acres of land generally located in eastern Travis County near the Village of Webberville and adjacent to the Colorado River and identified in **Exhibit "A"** attached to and incorporated as part of this ordinance is hereby released from the City of Austin's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

**PART 3.** This ordinance takes effect on November 29, 2021.



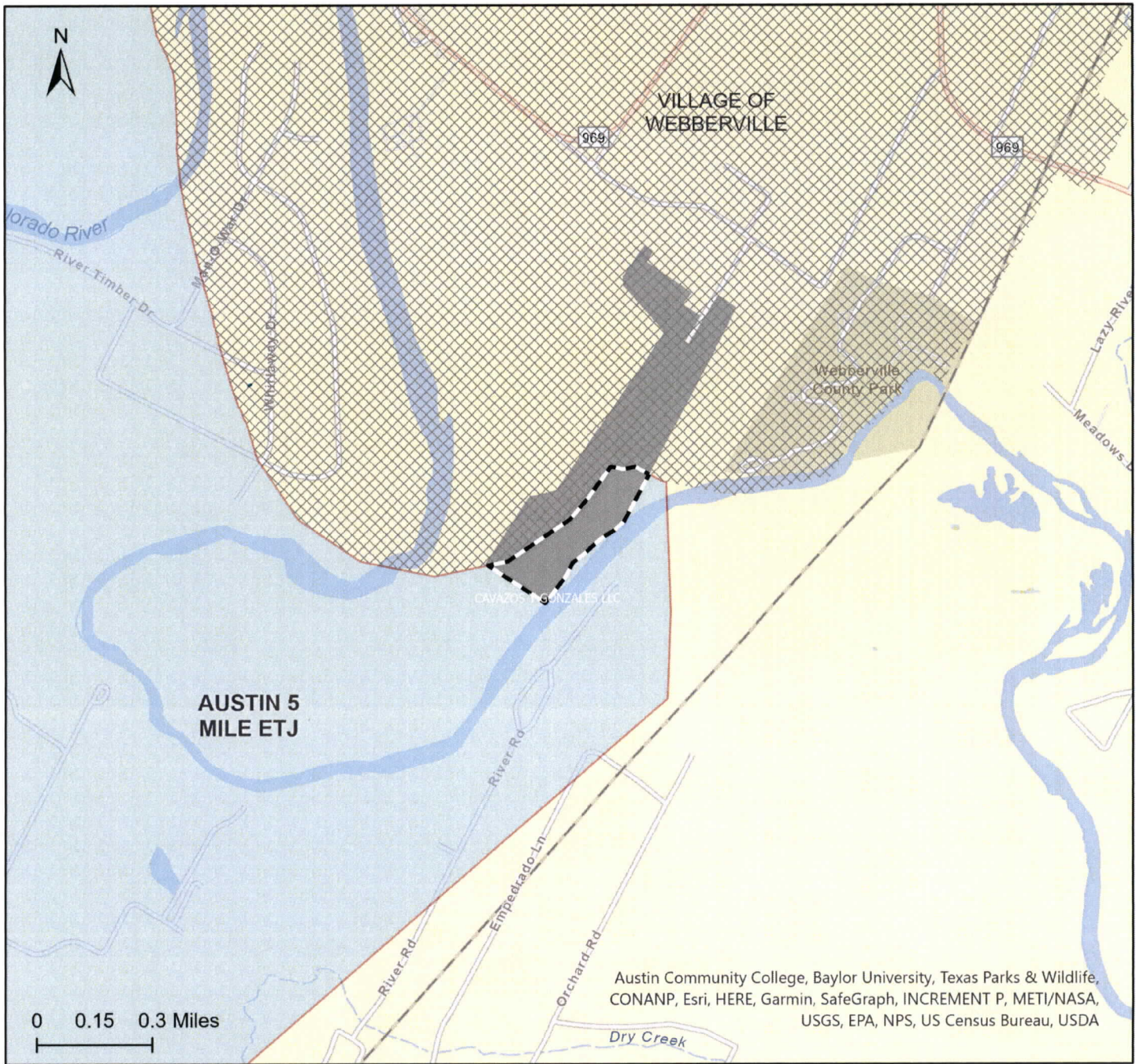

Proposed Release Area

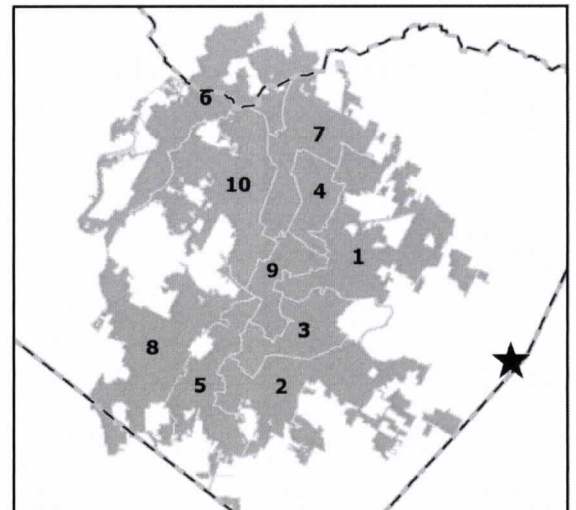
