ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This grant will assist with the installation of Level 2 electrical vehicle charging station infrastructure identified at four various sites within the City of Austin. A total of 13 charging stations and 26 charging ports will be installed to support the electrification of the City of Austin's fleet. A City funding match of \$7,200 or 20% is required. The remaining funding is available in the Fleet Mobility Services capital budget.
