ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This grant will assist with the purchase of multiple Level 2 charging equipment for light-duty zero emission vehicles identified at various sites within the City of Austin. A total of 18 charging stations will be installed to support the electrification of the City of Austin's fleet. A City funding match is not required. The remaining funding is available in the Fleet Mobility Services capital fund budget.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, Fleet Mobility Services' need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
