

Additional Direction

The City Council further affirms its commitment to improve labor protections for residents and includes the following direction:

- In executing the engagement and input provision of the resolution, City staff should engage with a wide range of stakeholders and differing substantive positions, engaging and soliciting input on the proposed ordinance from, without limitation, organizations that represent both labor and contractor/employer interests;
- As a part of developing recommendations and the ordinance draft, City staff should consider and present options for Council consideration that would contemplate different levels of new and additional city resources for intake, referral, investigation, and enforcement, including, with differing levels of new City staffing or funding that takes advantage of other entities' efforts and responsibilities (including but not limited to federal, state and local prosecutor investigation, adjudication and enforcement);
- As a part of developing any recommendations, City Staff should center the impact on the most vulnerable as the primary objective of any ordinance or programmatic consideration.
