Resolution No. 20210902-049 relating to the Special Events Task Force was approved on consent on Council Member Casar's motion, Council Member Ellis' second on a 10-0 vote. Council Member Alter was absent.

Resolution No. 20220127-089 directing the City Manager to draft a code amendment to implement the changes recommended by the Special Events Task Force in November of 2021.
