10	(TDHCA) for 9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the Proposed

12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN					
13	Pursuant to Section 11.3(c) of Texas' 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan and					
14	Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council					
15	expressly acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state					
16	average of units per capita supported by Housing Tax Credits or Private Activity					
17	Bonds.					

### 18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Pursuant to Section 11.3 of Texas' 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan, the City
Council acknowledges that the Proposed Development is located one linear mile or
less from a development that serves the same type of household as the Proposed
Development and has received an allocation of Housing Tax Credits or Private
Activity Bonds (or a Supplemental Allocation of 2022 credits) within the three
year period preceding the date Application Round begins.

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## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Pursuant to Section 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan,
the City Council acknowledges that the Proposed Development is located in a
census tract that has more than 20% Housing Tax Credit Units per total
households.

## 31 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the Proposed Development, approves the construction of the Proposed Development, authorizes an allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the Proposed Development, and affirms that the Proposed Development is consistent with the City's obligation to affirmatively further fair housing.

### 38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Pursuant to Section 11.9(d)(1) of Texas' 2022 Qualified Allocation Plan and
Section 2306.6710(b) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council confirms
that it supports the Proposed Development.
